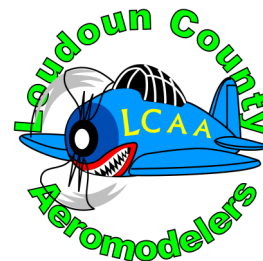


LCAA Airbag

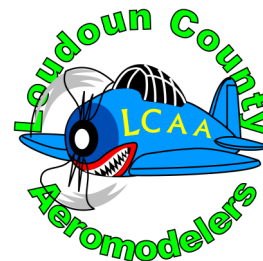
